

The EU Commission launched the Emergency Support Instrument, worth € 2.7 Billion and based on the principle of solidarity. The instrument was activated on 16 April 2020 to help Member States in their efforts to respond to the COVID-19 emergency.

The EU Commission has committed itself to support EU Member States, including Malta, with a grant of 1 Million Euros to partially cover costs incurred for the interoperability of the EU Digital COVID Certificate.

On the 16th August 2021 Malta – through the Ministry for Health – was awarded 1 Million to cover the eligible costs submitted by Malta for the implementation of the EU Digital COVID Certificate action.
